



Dear Friends and Neighbors,

This annual report captures the key financial information for 2018. The numbers reflect a healthy Palisades Village! We are pleased to report a balanced budget with a surplus of about \$21,000.

We continued to provide robust support to our Members with a mix of social events and services. Social events, such as holiday meals, cocktail parties, excursions to museums, and other gatherings provided our Members with much-needed personal interaction. Our Members received hundreds of

services, including transportation to medical and other appointments, household chores, tech support, friendly visits, case management support, referrals to support services and local businesses, errand-running, yard work, and other services. The Associate Members were active participants in our events and volunteered untold hours supporting all our services. A number of our Associate Members upgraded their membership to Full Members to take advantage of the wide variety of support services offered as their needs changed.

The number and quality of events in 2018 was impressive. Our dedicated volunteers and staff demonstrated tremendous innovation and leadership in giving our Members a wide array of wonderful events and activities to choose from. Our Pan Handlers provided outstanding culinary contributions and prepared and served special meals for our events. Palisades Village also supported yoga, storytelling, seminars, book club, and other special events. The 2018 House Tour, our primary fundraising event, was in our Foxhall and Palisades neighborhoods. The net income for the tour exceeded \$27,000. The 2019 House Tour planning is underway for October 19th.

We completed our second year of raising funds for our endowment to provide ongoing funds for Palisades Village well into the future. We thank all those who have given so generously and we will continue our efforts through 2019.

Palisades Village is fortunate to have an extremely supportive community, including many donors who provide the cushion we need to maintain our services and operations. We are all deeply grateful for your generosity.
