

The availability of vaccines made many activities possible again and helped us fight isolation, while considerably reducing the health risks posed by COVID-19. It was also a year that tested the effectiveness and flexibility of our service model. I am happy to report that we succeeded in our mission of keeping our community of older adults engaged and thriving.

It was a year where our community of members, volunteers, and donors rallied to support each other and the community at-large. Palisades Village was able to register and provide vaccination clinics for many of our vulnerable members. Our generous donors contributed more than in previous years, knowing we were not able to hold our in-person fundraising events. The DC government, through its Department on Aging and Community Living (DACL), along with other foundations such as the Washington Home Foundation, made generous contributions in recognition of the vital role we play in supporting older adults to remain engaged in their communities and living at home for as long as they can. We are looking forward to pushing our mission further and finding innovative ways to support our older adults, in collaboration with the other 12 Villages in the DC area.

We couldn't have done it without our many volunteers who provide rides to our members, whether to vaccination centers, medical appointments, grocery stores, as well as provide support with technology, and at-home improvements. We also continued our online cultural and educational events, our fitness, wellness, yoga, and "living on purpose" workshops, which all contribute to our quality of life and sense of engagement. We were also able to resume in-person events and hold community events such as our ice-cream social, BBQs, and Happy Hours.

We look forward to a new year, in which new challenges will no doubt surface, but in which we count on you to continue and redouble your support for the work of our Village, be it through your renewed memberships, donations, volunteering hours, and participation in our many activities and events. Together with our new Executive Director, Erica Blanton, and new Assistant Executive Director, Anne Ourand, our Board, and volunteers, we can't wait to continue providing the quality of services and events you have come to expect from us.
